## **30th Annual Conference on the Holocaust and Genocide: “Holocaust and Genocide: A Half-Century of Changing Narratives” Millersville University, Millersville, PA ★ April 14-16, 2010**

Millersville University's Annual Conference is the longest-running conference on the Holocaust and Genocide in North America. This year's meeting will bring together leading international scholars to discuss the themes of Jewish partisan resistance and the way in which the Holocaust and other genocides have evoked differing and sometimes conflicting narratives within the scholarly community and society at large.

**Keynote & Plenary Speakers:** **Yevgeny Yevtushenko** (Distinguished Professor of English, University of Tulsa) is a poet, novelist and filmmaker. His 1961 poem, “Babi Yar,” inspired Shostakovich’s “Symphony No. 13.” **Peter Black** (Senior Historian, US Holocaust Memorial Museum) worked in the Department of Justice’s Office of Special Investigations in the 1980s and 1990s, tracking and prosecuting suspected war criminals. **Klaus Fischer** is a cultural historian of Modern Europe and author of *Nazi Germany* and *History of an Obsession*. **Maxim Shrayer** (Professor of Russian, English & Jewish Studies, Boston College) translates and teaches Russian literature. A poet and author, his most recent book is *Yom Kippur in Amsterdam*. **Professor Lawrence Baron**, author of *Projecting the Holocaust into the Present*, will discuss the Holocaust in film. And **Ziv Bielsky** will speak about the movie “Defiance”—that tells the story of his father’s resistance to the Holocaust.
